Lake County is a DOR maintenance County. ORMAP grants have been used to scan deed records back to 1954, and all record surveys for Lake County. Part of the regional grant for survey scanning also granted funds to obtain additional control points necessary to achieve Goal 6 accuracy. The conversion program is now 100% complete with digital map maintenance accomplished by DOR Cartography.

### Timeline to complete maps:

Lake County received ORMAP funding spring of 2004 for year 1 of a 4 year conversion project to achieve Goal 4 tax lot maps. DOR Cartography will continue to maintain Lake County maps and provide Quality Control per ORMAP Contract # 1232. A new contract for 10,200 accounts at \$20.94 for contractor, IDS, requires additional \$113,722 in funding to complete project for estimated 18,027 tax lot/polyons. The additional funding is anticipated to be requested over the spring 07 and spring 08 funding cycles. Completion and maintenance was accomplished by DOR Cartography by August 2008 with a total of 18,222 tax lot/polygons.
