1. Introduction & Purpose of Plan

Brief history of digital mapping of taxlots:

In July of 2002 Malheur County entered into a contract with Department of Revenue (DOR) to perform the digital conversion of the Assessor's taxlot maps. There are 316 townships within Malheur County and, to date, 68% of those townships have been converted and received in a digital format. Currently, there are 327 tax maps that have been generated from the conversion process. Partnerships and secured grants have aided in the funding of the project. This project will result in Malheur County achieving ORMAP Goal 4 status of the Assessor's taxlot maps for use in a County Geographic Information System (GIS); Assessment and Taxation; and various uses by other county departments.
