

## ORMAP Reliability Attribute Fields

The addition of two new fields to the taxlot shapefile (*MapClass* and *MapRelCode*), these fields are mandatory. Counties would assess their data taxmap by taxmap; and a taxmap would be determined to meet [ORMAP Technical Specifications](#) if the County Cartographer verifies that at least eighty percent (80%) of the features on the map met the *ORMAP Technical Specifications*.

The new fields are:

- **MapClass:** The map classification can usually be determined by the scale of the Assessor's map.
- **MapRelCode:** Will identify as to how well the map meets the current *ORMAP Technical Specifications*. All tax maps will meet county A&T needs. Areas coded as "Excepted from Technical Specifications" are areas within a county that have no current business need to be mapped to the current ORMAP Technical Specifications. Once an area has been coded as such, it is ineligible for re-mapping funds until a future date specified by DOR.

MapClass	MapRelCode
U = Urban	01 = Meets or Exceeds Technical Specifications
R = Rural	02 = Technical Specifications not met
F = Farm/Forest (resource lands)	03 = Excepted from Technical Specifications

The metadata will include the methodology the county used to produce the tax maps. Recognizing not every county used the [ORMAP Map Methodology](#) document to produce their tax maps and associated taxlots. As long as the methodology that was used is documented and meets the "minimum critical elements" of mapping it would be acceptable
